DEPARTMENT HISTORY

A brief history of Management Science and Engineering at Stanford University:

Industrial Engineering (IE) was created as a program in the Administration Division of the Civil Engineering (CE) Department in 1945, headed by Eugene Lodewick Grant.

IE became an independent department in the School of Engineering in 1955, headed by W. Grant Ireson.

The Engineering Economic Systems (EES) program was created as an institute within the School of Engineering in 1962, chaired by William K. Linvill.

The Operations Research (OR) program was established in 1962 as an inter-departmental, inter-school academic unit, chaired by Gerald Lieberman.

EES became a department in the School of Engineering in 1967, chaired by William K. Linvill.

OR became a department in the School of Engineering in 1967, chaired by Gerald Lieberman.

The IE Department added Engineering Management to its mission and its name in 1977, becoming IEEM.

The EES and OR Departments merged in 1996, chaired by James L. Sweeney.

The EESOR and IEEM Departments merged to become the Department of Management Science and Engineering (MS&E) on January 1, 2000, chaired by M. Elisabeth Paté-Cornell.
